

Classes for Twos

Two year old students can meet two or three mornings per week - Monday and Wednesday, or Tuesday and Thursday, or Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Children are nurtured as they are introduced to the concept of being without their parents. A gathering time, free play, project, snack and outside play time fill up the three hours. Curriculum is centered around early literacy concepts of colors, shapes and word play, through Bible stories and nursery rhymes.



Classes for Threes

Three year old students have the option of attending two, three, or five days per week: Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings, or Tuesday and Thursday mornings or Monday-Friday mornings. Three year olds "work" on letter recognition and beginning number skills. Again these concepts are casually introduced through discovery, play, stories, nursery rhymes and literature.



Pre-Kindergarten

Pre-Kindergarten classes are designed to provide children classroom experiences through play and hands on learning activities that enhance growth in the areas of social-emotional and cognitive development. Using "Big Day for Pre-K", a literature-based curriculum, enriches the learning as well.



Our pre-kindergarten opportunities:
3 or 5 half days (9:00 to 12 noon) AND
Extended day (X-Bunch) available Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 12 noon to 3 pm.
X-Bunch children have lunch together, a recess period and then resume class time. X-Bunch will provide children themed, center-based activities throughout the year that will further develop their classroom experience. **Pre- K also has Friday STEM LAB!**



Tuition and Fees

Registration fee: \$60 per child; \$100 per family
Tuition is an annual amount divided over ten months
September through June.

Two days a week: \$242/month
Three days a week: \$340/month
Five days a week: \$492/month

Pre-k afternoon X-Bunch program: \$240/month
(12 noon to 3pm, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday)

Lunch and Learn program (daily)*:
Lunch only until 1:00 pm / 2 year olds \$10.00
Lunch bunch until 2:00 pm \$20.00
Afternoon specials prices vary by class. Pricing is found on registration form for classes.





Our Programs

All areas of growth and learning are integrated into a Christ-centered program which includes language and reading readiness, communication and socialization, fine and gross motor skills, self-reliance, listening and sharing and recognizing oneself and others as children of a loving God. We offer programs for two, three, four and five year old children.

Our school day is 9:00 am to 12 noon. Daily lunch bunch is available from 12 noon to 3:00, along with special, optional classes to enhance lunch bunch. Our Pre-K classes also have an afternoon "X-Bunch" program from 12 noon to 3 pm on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons.

Summer Camp

Our successful summer camp now runs 7 weeks each year! Parents love our flexible scheduling and our teachers transform into amazing camp counselors! Summer camp hours are 9 am to 12 noon, and optional lunch hour daily until 1 pm. The camp program is open to the community. Brochures become available in March.
